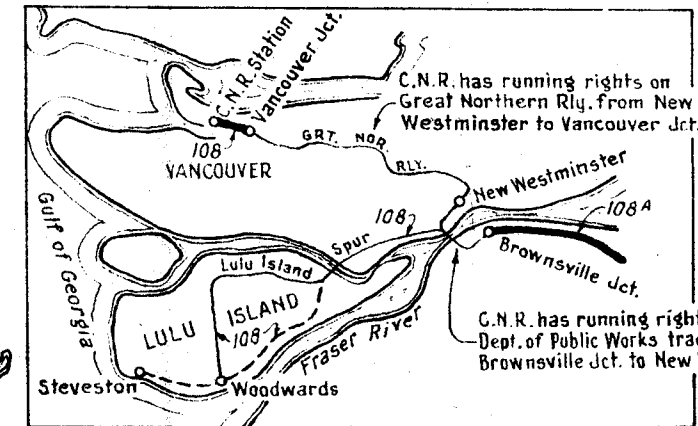

NOTES

From Entwishte to Red Pass Jc. the Can. Nat. Ry. Line is partly on Grand Trunk Pacific and Can. Northern Western Right of Way. A Composite Line was formed when 300 miles of rail was lifted for use overseas in war of 1914-18. - 150 miles from each Railway.

The Can. Nat. Rys. pass over the Tracks of the Vancouver, Victoria and Eastern Ry. between New Westminster and Vancouver. See No 28 on Map showing Independent Lines also.
