Ottawa Valley Ry. was constructed in 1892-93 and extends from Lachute to St. Andrews, Argenteuil county about 10 miles. It was operated for some years in harmony with the CPR but when that company acquired the M&O from Vaudreuil to Point Fortune opposite St. Andrews thus controlling the traffic on both sides of the Ottawa River, a dispute arose as to the terms for the exchange of traffic at Lachute and finding that it was impossible to work the line without loss it was closed and has not been operated since. It is proposed to utilize the line in connection with the proposed electric line which the Ottawa River co. has projected to connect Montreal and Grenville
