Ottawa Car and Aircraft - new plant at Uplands Airport.

Recent advice from Ottawa Car and Aircraft, Ltd., which is a member company of Canadian Associated Aircraft, Limited., and engaged in the manufacture of undercarriages, engine nacelles and engine mountings and fuel and oil tanks for Hampden bombers, is that it is progressing very favorably with the work being well ahead of scheduled deliveries to the parent company. The Ottawa company is also engaged in the manufacture of wings for Anson planes, as well as metal fittings for the wings, its contract for fittings covering the complete requirement of the Canadian production schedule. The company has also assembled a group of Ansons sent over from England, and, at the time of our advice, in the latter part of August, was beginning the assembly of an additional number. Also, it is producing various parts for Hurricane fighters, under a sub - contract from Canadian Car and Foundry Co. The company's new plant, at the Uplands airport, is being employed in aircraft assembly work. An illustration of this plant appears here-with.
