## PROPOSED NEW RAIL WAY

It is announced from Kingston that application will be made to Parliament for a charter empowering the Kingston and Dominion Central Railway to construct and operate an extension from a point between Brockville and Westport, to the city of Montreal, passing through the counties of Leeds, Grenville, Dundee, Glengarry, Soulanges, Vaudreuil, Jaques Cartier and Hochelaga, and an extension of the line from Newboro or Westport to Ottawa, passing through the counties of Lanark, Leeds and Carleton.

## RAILWAY COMMITTEE

The Kingston and Dominion Central railway bill was before the railway committee of the house yesterday, and was reported. The bill extends the time for the completion of the road and authorizes the construction of a branch from Newboro to Montreal and Newboro to Ottawa. The name was changed to the Dominion Central Railway company.
