Accidents

Analysis of Grand Trunk Lines October, 1922 to May 9, 1923.

In many cases accidents to motors at highway crossings over railways are due to the negligence of those driving cars. This negligence is to be found both at unprotected and protected crossings. The Grand Trunk lines from October 1922 to May 1923 show 54 cases where there was danger at protected crossings due to the negligence of those using the crossings. All but four of these cases were due to the carelessnedd of motor drivers. Notwithstanding safety devices and cautionary signals, people take chances and disregard safety. Motor accidents are becoming more frequent. Every sane motorist deplores this. If accidents are to be lessened, the sane motorist must educate the culpably negligent motorists; some of these actions are recorded in the following list from the Grand Trunk returns :-
