8 December 1906 from P.W. Teffler of Teffler Electric System to Minister

We have had submitted to us a proposition to build a certain railway line to be known as the Dominion Central, which it is proposed to build from Montreal by way of Newboro to Midland on Georgian Bay. The road is being promoted by Mr. Edward Smith of Prescott.

Asks for information in confidence.

16 March 1907 memorandum

Dominion Central Railway

Mr. Edward Smith of Prescott called here today leaving the attached plan. He stated capital being gotten together to build a double track electric line from Kingston to Ottawa on the charter which he has for this road. He also spoke of the intention of the Canadian Northern to parallel his line towards Kingston.

A large scale route plan is attached. Enormous - 4 inches to the mile but very crudely drawn and lettered. Dated 19 May 1900. This shows the existing railways in the area together with the Dominion Central with one line from Montreal via Newboro to Georgian Bay and a second line from Ottawa to Newboro and Kingston.
