Among the matters of interest of interest to this County which have recently come up in the Ontario Legislature is an Act of Incorporation of the Cobden and Opeongo Railway. The corporation will provisionally consist of James Worthington, Duncan McIntyre, Wm. Cassels, Wm. Houden, Wm. Murray, James C. Worthington, Thomas Murray, Wm. Moffatt, John H. Metcalfe and James Bonfield. The Company will have full power to construct and operate a railway from a point at or near or within the village of Cobden, on the line of the Canada Central Railway, at some point on the said railway, with full power to pass over any portion of the country between the points aforesaid and to construct the railway in sections. The capital of the railway shall be five hundred thousand dollars (with power to increase the same in the manner provided in the Railway Act) to be divided into five thousand shares of one hundred dollars each, and shall be raised by the persons and corporations who may become shareholders in such company. *Pembroke Observer*.
