Charter to Construct Railway Bridge at Gananoque Thrown Out

Railway Committee Decides that no More Charters will Granted for Bridging the St Lawrence

The article describes the defeat of a bill to incorporate the St Lawrence International Railway and Bridge Co. It also mentions that the bills of the Thousand Island Bridge and Railway Company, and Napanee, Tamworth and Quebec Railway Company to build bridges over the same place, were also thrown out for the same reason, they would interfere with navigation.

Note - this virtually leaves Brockville with the only charter for a railway bridge across the St Lawrence in this section, a fact which is likely to have much weight in securing the assistance of English capital. The decision of the House was last week cabled to Messrs Hervey and Cole now in London.
