30/11/1898 Pembroke Observer Toronto, Lindsay and Pembroke

The announcement printed in last observer (missing in microform) about the proposed Toronto, Lindsay and Pembroke Railway Company, has created great interest in this section. Already people have visions of a trough line to Toronto, which will shorten the distance nearly one hundred miles.

There is a likelihood that the Toronto, Lindsay and Pembroke railway will be built in the near future. 60 miles will complete the connection between Golden lake and Bancroft. Pembroke would then have a connection with Toronto at a distance of only 216 miles.
